TOTAL POINTS

A. COVER (10 Points Possible)

The sorority name (Epsilon Sigma Alpha International, Inc. chapter name, number, city and state, and year must appear on the cover and/or title page.) Books not meeting this requirement will be disqualified.

- 1. Cover portrays theme of book 5 pts. _____
- 2. Cover is durable enough to withstand handling and storage 5 pts. _____

B. CONTENT (90 Points Possible)

1. Quality of materials used (10 Points)

- a. Materials will withstand handling and time 5 pts. _____
- b. Photographs and other materials are placed securely 5 pts. _____

2. Originality (10 Points)

- a. The book's theme is creatively portrayed throughout 10 pts. _____

3. Arrangement of Materials (50 Points)

- a. Continuity 10 pts. _____
(Scrapbook should be organized by topic or chronologically)

- b. Coverage of current year's activities 20 pts. _____
(Events are adequately portrayed. It is not necessary to include all the photos taken of a particular event, but it is important to highlight different participants and activities that were aspects of that event.)

- c. Page Balance 10 pts. _____
(Materials should be placed in such a way as to afford a clear view of photos – good spacing is better than crowding.)

- d. Labeling 10 pts. _____
(All photos should be labeled for clarity. If the page already includes event names, date, and location information, that information needn't be repeated next to each photo. It is always best to use first and last names [or first initials and last names].)

3. Neatness (20 Points)

- a. All written materials and labels are legible (either typed, neatly printed, or in neat script). 10 pts. _____

- b. All materials should be attached neatly without excess glue. 10 pts. _____
