- A. PHYSICAL APPEARANCE ..... 25 Points**
1. Yearbook will not necessarily be of any particular size, but should be functional.
  2. The inside content should be mimeographed, typed or printed.
  3. The sorority name (Epsilon Sigma Alpha International, Inc.), chapter name and number, city, state, and year should appear on the cover or title page.
  4. Yearbook cover should be serviceable rather than decorative.
