The following wish list items directly impact the experience of campers in Camp Riley programs including programming and camper care. Areas that involve operational support, capital projects, and “big picture” needs are not included.

DAY-TO-DAY ITEMS

- **Baby wipes**
- **Batteries – especially C and D for flashlights**
- Beads – all shapes, sizes and colors for making necklaces and bracelets
- **Bug repellent WIPES – for campers with sensitive skin**
- **Bug spray (3M Ultrathon brand) – as recommended by Academy of Pediatrics**
- **Cloth shower curtains – more sanitary and resistant to mold**
- Construction paper
- Craft paint – non-toxic and washable
- Extension cords – indoor and outdoor and 3-prong adapters
- **Fitted twin sheets and twin sheet sets**
- **Latex free disposable gloves**
- **Markers (non-toxic & washable), pens and colored pencils**
- **Masking tape and duct tape**
- Nalgene or hard plastic water bottles
- Paintbrushes
- Poster board
- Rolls of BANNER paper (for large signs, carnivals, etc.)
- S'ghetti string/hemp string – for making bracelets and necklaces
- Scissors
- Sharpie permanent markers
- **Sun lotion or Sun block – preferably waterproof**
- **Tie dye supplies (white t-shirts, ink, disposable plastic gloves)**
- Towels – bath towels and beach towels
- **Zipper pillow protectors and pillowcases**

EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES

- Adaptive Supplies/Independent Living Supplies
 - ◆ Eating and drinking equipment
 - ◆ Adaptive program supplies
 - ◆ Adaptive recreational equipment
 - ◆ Adaptive/Independence building toys, games and activities
 - ◆ Sensory stimulation games, toys and supplies
- Outdoor Recreation Equipment
 - ◆ **Lifejackets / PFD's**
 - ◆ **Sleeping bags**
 - ◆ **Tents**
 - ◆ Backpacks
 - ◆ Sleeping pads
- Electronics – for use by campers in cabins and by staff to have slideshows and other special events for the campers.
 - ◆ digital camera
- Housekeeping and Camper Linens – each camper is provided with linens for their stay.
 - ◆ **Sheets, Blankets, Pillow Covers, Mattresses, Floor Exercise and Lounging Mats, Mattress Covers to replace those that are in disrepair**
