

CAUCUS GUIDELINES

I C CONVENTION

1. The State President – or her representative – shall maintain complete control of the caucus for the duration of the caucus.
2. Every Indiana Delegate in attendance – in good standing – is automatically an official voting delegate whether or not her chapter has named her a voting delegate or not.
3. Any chapter with an official delegate in attendance...who has specified that chapter's choice of candidate(s) for any office shall be cast by that chapter's official delegate....as so directed by the chapter.
4. Any chapter not represented at convention, who has specified their choice of candidate(s) for any office, shall be cast by the State President or her representative – as per their instructions...in the event that chapter does not have a delegate in attendance and there are not sufficient number of Indiana Delegates in attendance for official voting privileges.
5. All proxy votes carried by the State President – or her representative – shall be cast in accordance with the final decision made at the caucus by all delegates in attendance at the caucus.
6. The qualifications of each candidate for an International Council Office – where there are two or more candidates in competition – shall be reviewed by the State President – or her representative – at the caucus,
7. Each delegate in attendance at the state caucus will be allowed to speak pro or con – or ask questions – with helpful information or knowledge – on behalf of any candidate in competition in any office, in the event she so desires.
