“WHAT ESA MEANS TO ME” ESSAY GUIDELINES

**Entries are judged prior to State Convention and are
SUBMITTED TO THE AWARDS CHAIRMAN BY MAY 15, 2020.**

1. There are two (2) categories:
 - a. New members who have been active in ESA less than one year.
 - b. Members who have been active in ESA more than one year.
2. Member’s Name, Chapter Name, Chapter Number, and Member’s pledge date shall appear at the top of the essay.
3. The essay **MUST BE 300 WORDS OR LESS**.
4. Certificates shall be awarded to the three (3) outstanding essays in each category, and the two (2) first place essays will be printed in the September issue of *The Lamp*. The two first place essays will also be submitted to ESA Headquarters for International competition.
5. Essays will be judged on the following criteria:
 - a. Originality30 Points
 - b. Purpose50 Points
(some mention of ESA’s three-fold purpose: Philanthropic, Educational and Social)
 - c. 300 WORDS OR LESS 10 Points
 - d. Neatness (typed or printed neatly)..... 10 Points
